The existing Novar Wind Farm located on land (the 'Site') within the Novar Estate which is approximately 11 km north of Dingwall and 9 km northwest of Alness, in the Cromarty Firth in northern Scotland and in the jurisdiction of The Highland Council. Address for existing wind farm: Novar Wind Farm, Boath Road, Alness, V17 0XJ

The Site location is shown on Figure 1, Appendix 1.

Description of Development

The Proposed Development would comprise the full repowering of the existing Novar Wind Farm to include the removal of the existing 34 turbines (60m tip height), and the construction of a maximum of 10 new wind turbines, each of a maximum blade tip height of 180 m, and associated infrastructure. The total installed capacity of the proposed turbines would be approximately 60 MW.

The design of the turbine layout and associated infrastructure will be informed by the EIA process and ongoing survey work. Existing access tracks and infrastructure will be reused where possible.

Due to the installed capacity of the Proposed Development being greater than 50 MW, an application for consent will be made to the Scottish Ministers under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989, not through the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997.

There is no statutory requirement to undertake pre-application consultation for section 36 applications under the Electricity Act 1989 and, therefore, the provision of this Proposal of Application Notice (PAN) has been done on a voluntary basis and as requested by The Highland Council. It is important to note the voluntary basis on which this PAN has been submitted and, therefore, that the requirements of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 in relation to the timescales to application submission and timing of consultation events, is not restricted by the timescales of a formal PAN.

The Applicant is keen to engage directly with The Highland Council, and other key consultees, throughout the design development of the Proposed Development to shape the scale and layout. This has been demonstrated to date via the Applicant's voluntary pre-application consultation meeting with The Highland Council on 14th August 2024. A response pack from The Highland Council following this meeting was received on 12th September 2024.

A Scoping Report for the Proposed Development was submitted to the Energy Consent Unit (ECU) on 23 January 2025 (ECU00006087). The Scoping Opinion was received 7th May 2025.

The first round of public exhibitions was held on 4th and 5th March 2025 at three different local venues (refer to further details below). These exhibitions considered the advice provided by The Highland Council within the pre-application consultation meeting and response pack (refer to above).

A second round of public exhibitions is proposed in August / September 2025 aligned closely to the design development programme. The exact dates and venues are still to be confirmed.

The section 36 application is expected to be submitted in Q4 2025.
