Report Title: Major Development Update

Purpose/Executive Summary

This report provides an update on progress of all cases within the ‘Major’ and ‘National’ development categories currently with the Planning and Development Service for determination. The report also details progress on proposals submitted under Section 36 or Section 37 of the Electricity Act 1989 on which the Council is consulted.

Recommendation

Members are asked to note the current position of these applications.

1. Update on Progress

- 1.1 Appendix 1 contains a list of all applications for Major Development or National Development currently with the Service and awaiting determination. A brief update on the progress of these applications is provided, including a likely timescale for each case to be determined.
- 1.2 Appendix 2 provides a list of all significant Electricity Act applications. It should be noted that for many of these, the Council has already provided its response to Scottish Government. Only once Scottish Ministers determine these cases will they be removed from the list. From a performance point of view, the Council is not required to meet the same target timescales expected with planning applications.
- 1.3 Appendix 3 provides a list of all major scale planning permissions and Electricity Act consents issued within the last two years to provide members with an update on the status of these developments.
- 1.4 Details for any of these applications can be obtained through the Council's e-planning portal <http://wam.highland.gov.uk/wam> by entering the respective case reference number provided. The following abbreviations have been used in the appendices:
 - PCO – Pending Consideration
 - PDE – Pending Decision
 - S36RO – raised an objection to an application for energy generation under the Electricity Act
 - S36RNO – raised no objection to an application for energy generation under the Electricity Act
 - S37RO – raised an objection to an application for energy transmission under the Electricity Act
 - S37RNO – raised no objection to an application for energy transmission under the Electricity Act

2. Delegated Refusals of Major Applications and Current Appeals

- 2.1 Since the Major Developments Update Report presented to the last South Planning Applications Committee, no major application has been refused using delegated powers.
- 2.2 Progress with applications where the Council has raised objection:
 - i. 23/05579/S36 - Culachy Wind Farm - Erection and operation of a wind farm for a period of 35 years, comprising 8 wind turbines with a maximum blade tip height of 200m, access tracks, underground cabling, substation, maintenance building, batching plant, borrow pits and ancillary infrastructure. Application reported to Committee in October 2024 where members agreed to raise an objection as per officer recommendation. A PLI is anticipated to take place in October 2025 to be held in Fort Augustus.

- ii. 23/02462/S36 – Loch Liath Wind Farm - Erection and operation of a wind farm for a period of 35 years, comprising a total of 13 wind turbines with Turbines 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13 having a maximum blade tip height of 200m, and Turbines 1, 6 and 7 having a maximum blade tip height of 180m, access tracks, borrow pit, substation, control building, anemometer mast, and ancillary infrastructure. Application reported to Committee in February 2025 where members agreed to raise an objection as per officer recommendation. A PLI is anticipated to take place in November 2025 be held in Fort Augusts.
- iii. Dell 2 Wind Farm (Re-design) - Erection and operation of a wind farm for a period of 35 years, comprising of 9 wind turbines, 4 with a maximum blade tip height of 180m and 5 with a maximum blade tip height of 200m, access tracks, borrow pits, substation, control building, and ancillary infrastructure. An in time holding objection has been lodged with the Energy Consents Unit on 26 June 2025, with the application due to be reported to SPAC in Q3 or Q4 2025 ahead of any PLI commencing.
- iv. Loch Kemp - Construction and operation of pumped hydro storage; dam, raise, and utilise Loch Kemp, as its upper reservoir, and connect by underground waterway systems and tunnels to a powerhouse and tailrace structure on the shores of Loch Ness. The application was reported to Committee in June 2025 where members raised objection, contrary to officers recommendation. The application will now be subject to a PLI, the arrangements for which are awaited, ahead of Scottish Ministers determination.
- v. 24/05097/S36 - Knocknagael BESS - Construction and operation of a 200MW Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) comprising two BESS and one substation compounds, associated infrastructure, site access, and landscaping. A holding objection has been lodged with the Energy Consents Unit, with a subsequent extended consultation period having been agreed between the parties until 29 August 2025. Application to be reported to SPAC in Q3 2025.
- vi. 25/02301/S37 - Bingally 400 kV Substation Overhead Line Tie-in-Install and keep installed two new 400kV steel lattice towers and approximately 1.6km of overhead line (including a temporary diversion requiring two temporary towers) to facilitate the tie-in of the existing Beaully-Denny overhead line into the proposed Bingally 132/400kV substation, associated ancillary infrastructure including access tracks, construction laydown area and compound. A holding objection has been lodged with the Energy Consents Unit, with the application anticipated to be reported to committee in Q4 2025 timeously with the proposed Bingally substation.
- vii. 25/02993/S37 - Beaully - Denny Overhead Line Diversion - The temporary and permanent diversion of approximately 1.7km section of the existing 275/400kV Beaully Denny overhead line (OHL). A holding objection has been lodged with the Energy Consents Unit, with the application anticipated to be reported to committee in Q4 2025 timeously with the

proposed Fanellan substation.

- 2.3 For those cases under the Electricity Act 1989 where a Public Local Inquiry has been held and we are awaiting the decision of the Scottish Ministers the case will be listed in the Appendix to this report only.

3. Recent Decisions by Scottish Ministers and Judicial Reviews
