## 1. Purpose/Executive Summary

- 1.1 This report provides an update of key information in relation to the schools within the Portree High Associated School Group (ASG) and provides useful updated links to further information in relation to these schools.
- 1.2 The primary schools in this area serve 558 pupils, ELC settings serve 142 children (114 in LA settings and 28 in Partner settings as at September Census), with the secondary school serving 489 young people.






