(b) to a future meeting of the Committee when the applications will be determined in terms of the Hearings Procedure.

There had been circulated to members only Report No HLC/159/25 by the Principal Solicitor relating to Ronald Morrison who is the holder of a private hire car driver's licence (Ward 14 – Inverness Central). The Committee was invited to determine the matter in accordance with the Council's Hearings Procedure.

The Committee heard from Police Scotland and Ronald Morrison. applicant.

Mr R Stewart, seconded by Mr S Kennedy, **MOVED** to take no further action in relation to the private hire car driver's licence.

As an **AMENDMENT**, Ms E Knox, seconded by Mrs J Hendry, moved to suspend the licence holder's private hire car driver's licence for the unexpired portion of the duration of the licence, with immediate effect, under paragraph 11(2)(a) of Schedule 1 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982.

On a vote being taken, the **MOTION** received 5 votes and the **AMENDMENT** received 5 votes, with no abstentions, the votes having been cast as follows:-
