Report Title: Inverness and Area Community Funding Update

Report By: Assistant Chief Executive – Place

1 Purpose/Executive Summary

1.1 This report provides an update in respect of funding allocated by The Highland Council to community projects across the City of Inverness and Area for financial years 2022/23 to 2025/26, including:-

- Ward Discretionary Funds;
- Invitation to Pay (Parking) Funds;
- Covid Fund;
- Place Based Investment Fund;
- Scottish Government Capital Playpark Allocations;
- Regeneration Capital Grant Fund;
- Place Based Investment Programme;
- UK Shared Prosperity Fund;
- Coastal Communities Fund;
- Community-led Local Development Fund;
- Nature Restoration Fund;
- Reuse & Repair Fund; and
- Inverness Common Good Fund

1.2 In total, the **643 grants awarded** across these 13 funding streams representing an **investment of £5,189,170** in community projects across the City and Area. Section 6 of this report provides an overview of grant allocations and the decision-making process for each fund. A detailed list of grant awards for each fund can be found in the appendices.

2 Recommendations

- 2.1 Members are asked to **scrutinise** and **note** the use of funding allocations to community projects across the City and Area Committee geography for financial years 2022/23 to 2025/26.

4 Impacts

5 Background

- 5.1 This report provides an overview of funding allocated by The Highland Council to community projects across the City of Inverness and Area for financial years 2022/23 to 2025/26.

6 Funding Allocations

6.1 Community grant awards by fund type (April 2022 - March 2026):-

- 6.2 **Ward Discretionary Fund:** decisions in respect of the Ward Discretionary Fund allocations were taken by the Community Support and Engagement Team, following consultation with Ward Members. The annual Discretionary Fund allocation for each ward was £16,000 between 2022/23 and 2023/24 and for 2024/25 to 2025/26, it was £14,381. Projects supported by Ward Discretionary Funds for those financial years are set out within **Appendix 1**, representing a total allocation of £459,128.97 across 334 grants.
- 6.3 The Ward Discretionary Fund allocation for 2026/27 has been increased to £19,381 per Ward and funds are currently available for applications from eligible community groups. - 6.4 **Invitation to Pay Fund (ITP):** since 2023/24, a portion of net revenue from discretionary parking income has also been available for community projects in Wards 12 and 13. This was awarded on the same basis as for Ward Discretionary Funding. Projects receiving ITP support are detailed within **Appendix 2**, with 15 grants representing a total allocation of £35,353.37.
- 6.5 **Place Based Investment Funding (PBIF)** and repurposed unspent **Covid Ward Funds** were also awarded on the same basis as for Ward Discretionary Funding. Projects receiving PBIF support are detailed within **Appendix 4**, representing a total allocation of £297,194.99. Projects receiving repurposed Covid Ward Fund support are detailed within **Appendix 3**, totalling £87,081.99.

- 6.6 Decisions taken in respect of **Scottish Government Capital Playpark Allocations** were taken by the City and Area Committee. Use of these funds is set out within **Appendix 5**, with 26 allocations representing a total of £778,970.51.
- 6.7 **Community Regeneration Funding (CRF)** refers to several community-led external funding programmes, administered by the Highland Council. Eligible community groups can notify their interest in funding by registering a project proposal online at the BeConnected website: <https://highland.communitychoices.scot/proposals>
- 6.8 The City and Area Committee made decisions in respect of the following CRF funds. The use of each fund is set out in the corresponding listed appendix:-
- i. **Place Based Investment Programme** – 22 grants with a total value of £1,240,484.03 - **Appendix 7**;
 - ii. **UK Shared Prosperity Fund** – 9 grants with a total value of £285,533.61 - **Appendix 8**;
 - iii. **Coastal Communities Fund** – 9 grants with a total value of £304,755.30 - **Appendix 9**
- 6.9 Allocations and decision making for the further Highland wide CRF programmes were as follows:-
- i. **Regeneration Capital Grant Fund (Appendix 6)** applications were reviewed and recommended for submission to the Scottish Government by the CRF Strategic Subgroup, which comprises the Chairs of Economy and Infrastructure and Area Committees. An award of £602,500 was secured for a project in the Inverness area during the period reported on.
 - ii. Decisions on the **Community Led Local Development (CLLD) Fund** were made by Highland Strategic Local Action Group (**Appendix 10**). Five grant awards were made for projects in Inverness, with a total value of £93,240.
 - iii. Decisions on the **Nature Restoration Fund** were delegated to the Chair of Economy and Infrastructure Committee and Assistant Chief Executive - Place (**Appendix 11**) and homologated at the Economy and Infrastructure Committee. Fifteen grant awards were made to projects in the Inverness area, with a total value of £130,347.
 - iv. Decisions on the **Re-Use & Repair Fund** were delegated to officers and homologated at Communities and Place Committee (**Appendix 12**). Two grants were awarded within the Inverness area, with a total value of £51,330.
- 6.10 **Inverness Common Good Fund:** Decisions on grants up to and including £10,000 were made by the Common Good Fund Sub-Committee. There were 115 grants between April 2022 and March 2026, totalling £531,078. For applications over £10,000, the Sub-Committee make recommendations for decision making by the City of Inverness Area Committee. There were 14 grants of this value between April 2022 and March 2026, totalling £292,172. Use of these funds is set out in **Appendix 13**.
