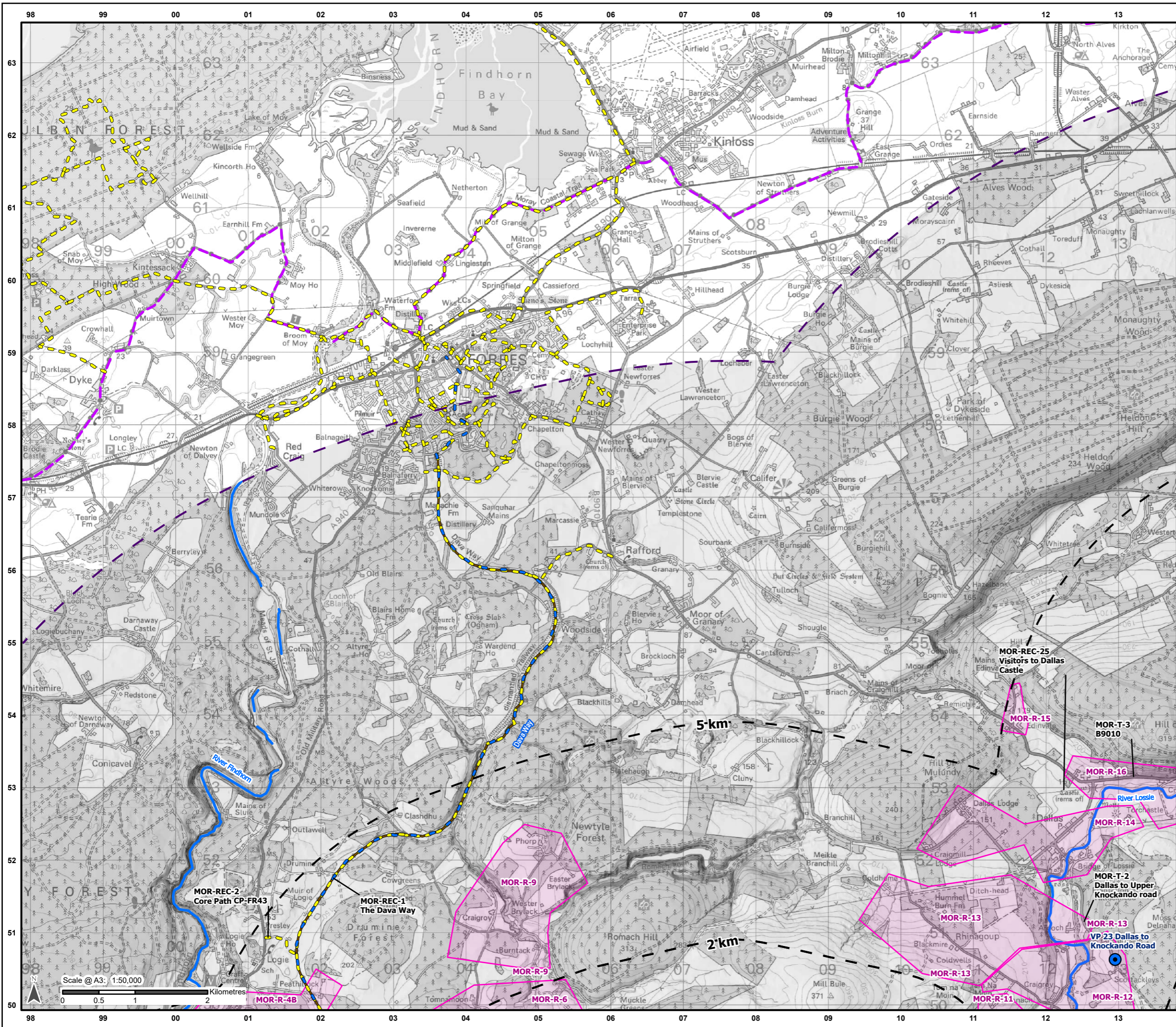

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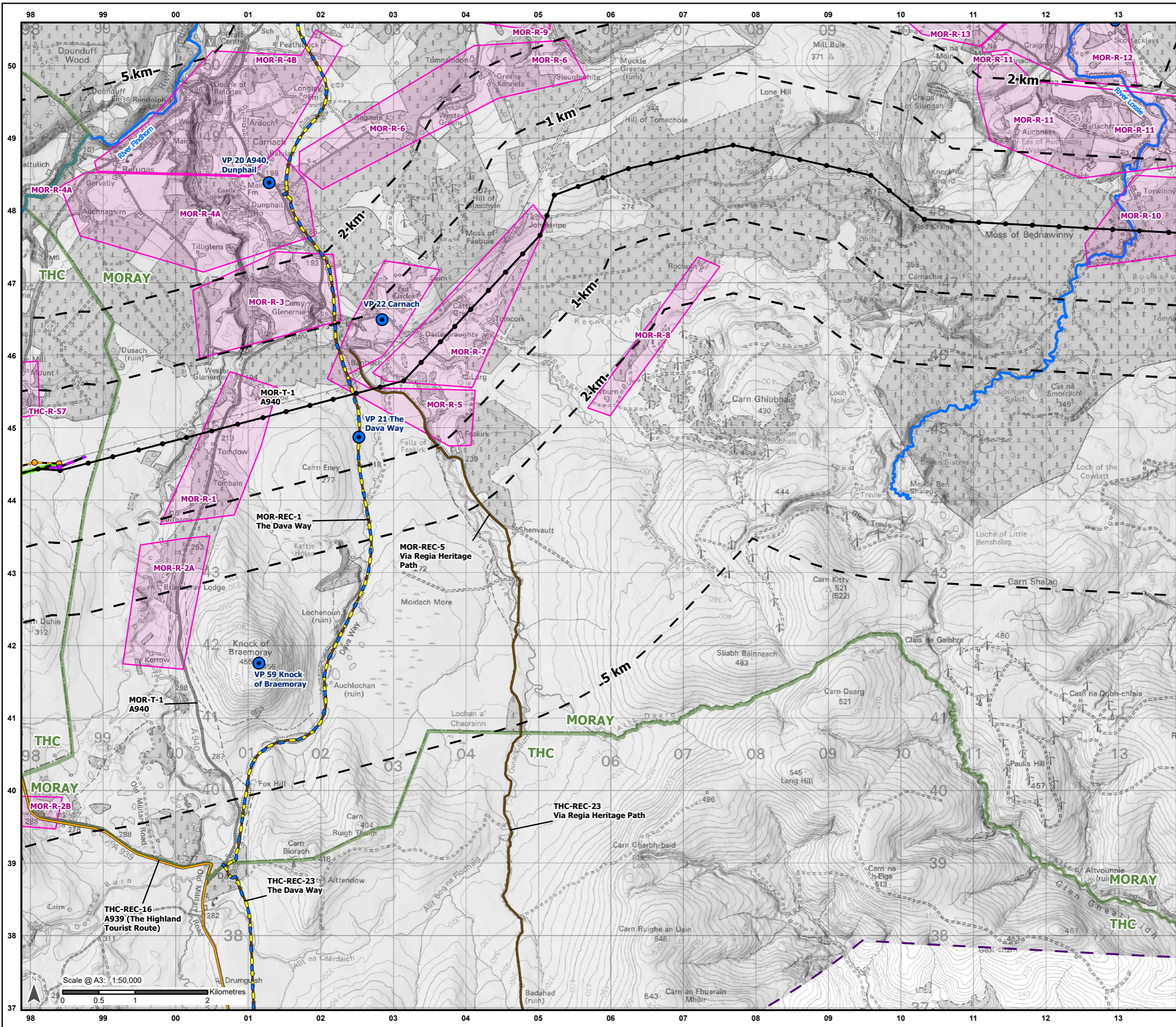

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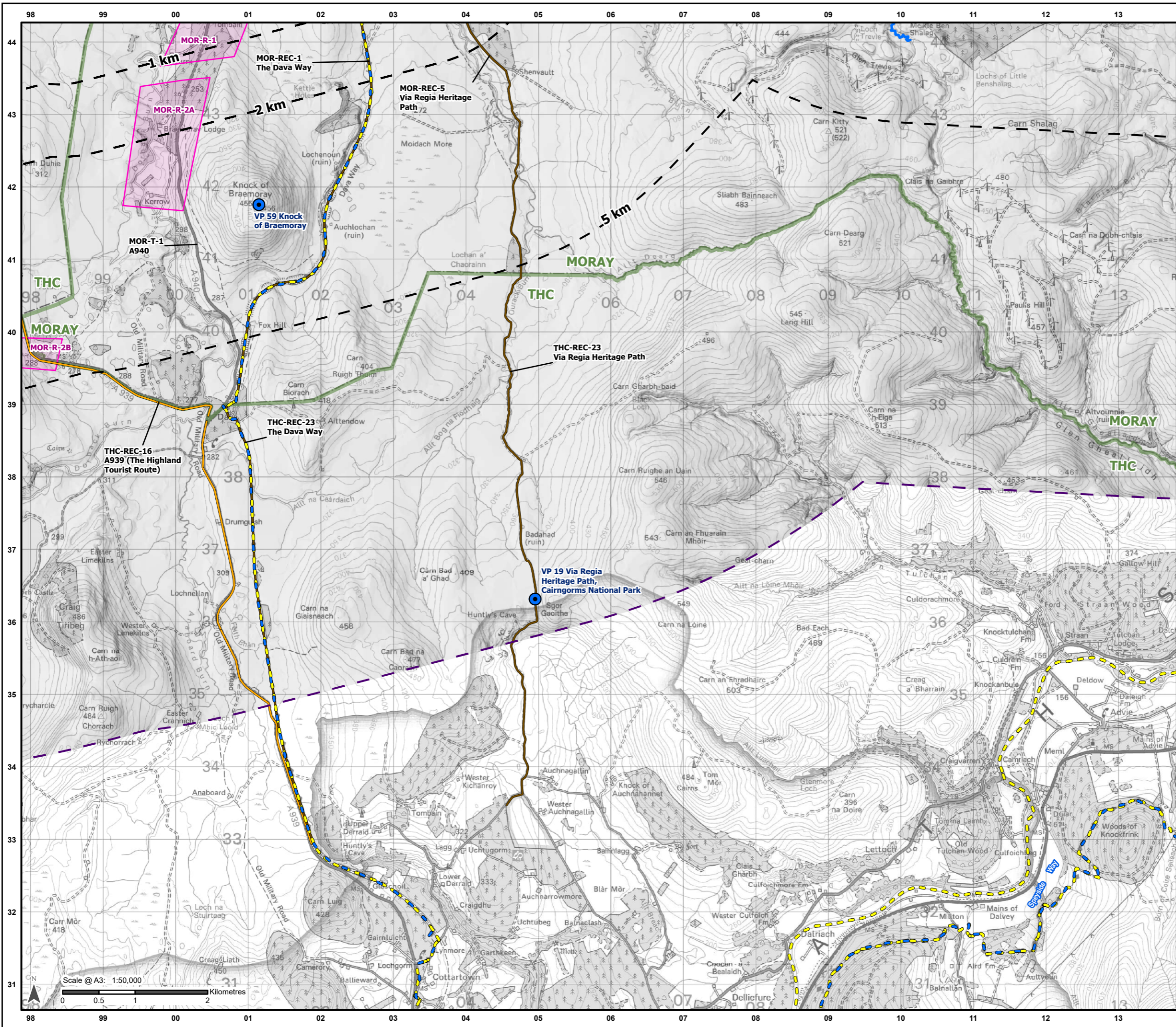

Title: Figure 7.6 - Visual Amenity Receptors and Viewpoint Locations  
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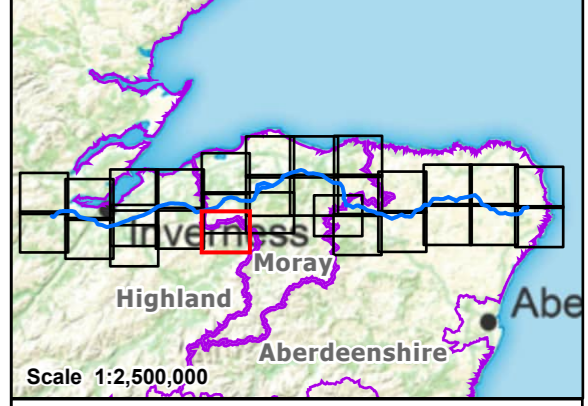
