# Household Emergency Plan

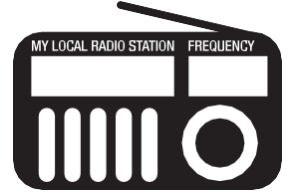
What would you and your family do if an emergency happened?
