<b>Club Gaming Permits and Club Machine Permits<sup>iv</sup></b>  A club gaming permit allows up to 3 category B, C or D machines and equal chance gaming in members' clubs, commercial clubs or miners' welfare institutes.  A club machine permit allows up to 3 category B, C or D machines in members' clubs and miners welfare institutions.	<b>New applications</b>	<b>£200</b>

<b>Unlicensed Family Entertainment Centre Gaming Machine Permits<sup>v</sup></b>  This permit allows category D machines in FECs which do not have an operating licence and a premises licence. FECs offering category C and D machines require both an operating licence and a premises licence.	<b>New applications</b>	<b>£300</b>

<b>Prize Gaming Permits<sup>vi</sup></b>  Permits allowing prize gaming on premises which do not hold a premises licence (under the Gambling Act 2005) or a club gaming permit.	<b>New applications</b>	<b>£300</b>

<b>Temporary Use Notices<sup>vii</sup></b>  Notice to allow a holder of an operating licence permission to hold a temporary, special gambling event.	<b>Notice fee</b>	<b>£350</b>
<b>Small Society Lottery Registration</b>	<b>New applications</b>  <b>Annual fee</b>	<b>£40</b>  <b>£20</b>
