CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982

ITINERANT METAL DEALER'S LICENCE: SCHEDULE OF CONDITIONS

1. Any change of address(es) of the licence holder must be notified to the licensing authority before or as soon as reasonably practicable after the change of address(es) has taken place.

2. The licence holder shall carry on his business only on the following days of the week - [as per current licence conditions]

and between the following hours each day -

3. The licence holder shall comply with all legislative provisions affecting his trade and in particular all relevant provisions of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 and any orders made thereunder

4. Where the licence holder is a tenant of, or resides in, a local authority dwellinghouse, no metal dealing business shall be carried out from the place of residence without the written consent of the Council.

5. No metal should be kept or stored in the house or grounds of the licence holder.
