

## Declaration of Results

This report is the Declaration of Results script for Returning Officer.

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Black Isle

I will now declare the result of the election in the Black Isle. There are 3 Councillors to be elected.

The electorate was 8,842 and the number of ballot papers received was 4,752 giving a percentage turnout of 53.7%. There were 43 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 1,178.

The number of first preference votes for each of the candidates was:
