

**THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (C1094 GLEN ETIVE ROAD, GLENCOE) (WEIGHT
LIMIT) ORDER 2025**

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1(1) and 2(1), (2) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, being satisfied that for the purpose of avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road aforementioned, it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the said Act should not apply to this order, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The Highland Council (C1094 Glen Etive Road, Glencoe) (Weight Limit) Order 2025” and shall come into effect on
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Any order made prior to this Order which imposes a weight restriction on the length of road aforementioned is hereby revoked.
4. No person shall use or cause permit to be used any vehicle of which the maximum gross weight whether loaded or unloaded exceeds 18 tonnes on the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.
