THE HIGHLAND REGIONAL COUNCIL (SMITHTON AND BALLOCH, INVERNESS)  
(SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 1995

The Highland Regional Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Highland Regional Council (Smithton and Balloch, Inverness) (Speed Limits) Order, 1995" and shall come into operation on 23 November 1995.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. No person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour over the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
4. No person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour over the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
5. The Highland Regional Council (Balloch) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 1982 and Highland Regional Council (Smithton-Balloch Distributor Road) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 1990 are hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE 1


Route C7 - Balloch to Culloden Moor Road

From its junction with Barn Church Road south eastwards to a point 91 metres or thereby southwest of the centre line of route U313, Viewhill Road, a total distance of 1.52 kilometres or thereby.

SCHEDULE 2

Route C8 - Barn Church Road

From a point 127 metres or thereby west of the centre line of Caulfield Road northeastwards to a point 50 metres or thereby northeast of the centre line of the route U76, Upper Cullernie Road a total distance of 2.525 kilometres or thereby.
