Your comments: Main concerns regarding proposals is the addition of a public building attached to the school's whilst we have been told that it would be secure etc. we have children that are a flight risk and with communities now no longer like they used to be (knowing everyone in the village) and the relocation of offenders of all aspects of crime to small communities, this, as a mother and an employee of the school genuinely scares me.

One other aspect I was told about today was that the safer routes for school is being looked at.

With regards to the current routes to school, the top end (Braeview entrance) has a lollipop lady for safe crossing for children whereas the route up croyard road to the school has no help for crossing to school. Both routes are via the main road through Beauly, and as a member of staff and mother to a child who walks to school everyday (from Croyard Road entrance) this route is not safe. Cars very regularly do not stop at the red lights. It has also been reported to the police and our local community police as it's so so dangerous. Safe routes to school should be manned and not have children walk via a main road. Perhaps children coming from the Croyard road side of the village would benefit for a safer route to school.

Number one is children's safety, hence the new building as the current one is, to be blunt, an absolute disgrace. I feel that a safer route for all children away from main roads is essential for safety and that the addition to a public building to a school is a huge safety concern.
