Limit of Candidates Election Expenses

The Limit on Candidates' Election Expenses per elector in the above noted constituency on Wednesday 25 March (i.e. last date for publication of the Notice of Election) is based on a maximum sum of:

Long Campaign	Short Campaign
– began on 7 January 2026 and ends on the day you officially become a candidate (The earliest date you can officially become a candidate is 26 March 2026)	– begins the day after you officially become a candidate and ends on polling day Thursday 7 May 2026
£21,500 + 6.3p per elector in a county constituency	£8,700 + 9p per elector in a county constituency
