EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026**

**Statement of Reasons**

The Highland Council aim to promote the safe and efficient use of the roads they are responsible for. Where these roads link towns, villages and cities, there are frequently competing pressures between their strategic purpose, and community interests relating to safety and amenity.

In the interests of road safety, specifically child safety, as well as casualty reduction, and in support of Council policy to promote safer roads across the network, it is proposed to introduce temporary driving restrictions at the locations and times detailed below:

**U2098 Culloden Park, Inverness**

08:30-9:15am and 14:15-15:15pm.

**C1092 St Mary's Road, Inverness**

08:30-9:15am and 2.45 – 3.45pm from Monday to Thursday, and Fridays 08:30-9:15am and 11.45 – 12.30pm.

**U4301 Trostan Road, Thurso**

08:15 - 9:15am and 2.15 – 3.30pm from Monday to Thursday, and Fridays, 08:15-9:15am and 12.15 – 13.00pm.
