

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (A838 TONGUE) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council proposes to make an Order in terms of Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 entitled as above.

If the Order comes into force, the Order will introduce a 30mph speed limit on the following roads in Tongue over their entire length, unless stated otherwise below:

Route A838, Lairg – Tongue Road

From a point 45 metres or thereby north of the centre line of Route U1643, extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 470 metres or thereby.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a copy of the relevant plan, the Authority's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order along with THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (TONGUE) (20 MPH. 30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2008, which will be revoked in part if the proposed order comes into force can be inspected at the Bettyhill (Kirkton and Tongue) Service Point and Registration Office, Naver-Tele Service Centre, Bettyhill, KW14 7SS, during normal opening hours from Monday to Friday, 9:00 to 12:30, from the 1st May to the 29th May 2026.
