


THE HIGHLAND REGIONAL COUNCIL (ELGOL ROAD, BROADFORD, SKYE)

RESTRICTED ROAD (ORDER) 1991


The Highland Regional Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 82 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Highland Regional Council (Elgol Road, Broadford, Skye), Restricted Road (Order) 1991".
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. It is directed that the length of road in Broadford, Skye specified in the Schedule to this Order is a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the said Act of 1984.
4. That part of the Schedule headed "Schedule Broadford 30 m.p.h. speed restriction" and specified as "route A881 Broadford - Elgol Road" to the Highland Regional Council Transitional Order - Restricted and Non-Restricted Roads is hereby revoked.
5. This Order shall come into operation on 3rd March, 1992.
