

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (A838 TONGUE) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council on the 29th July 2026 made, in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the above Order which will come into operation on 14th August 2026.

The Order was previously advertised by Notice in The Northern Times on the 1st May 2026 and the effect of the Order is as described in that Notice.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a copy of the relevant plan, the Authority's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order along with THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (TONGUE) (20 MPH. 30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2008, which will be revoked in part if the proposed order comes into force can be inspected at the Bettyhill (Kirkton and Tongue) Service Point and Registration Office, Naver-Tele Service Centre, Bettyhill, KW14 7SS, during normal opening hours from Monday to Friday, 9:00 to 12:30, from the 7th August to the 18th September 2026. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that a requirement of that Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the Court of Session.
