

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (B9006 CULLODEN CROSSROADS) (40mph Speed Limit) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council on the 29th July 2026 made, in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the above Order which will come into operation on 14th August 2026.

The Order was previously advertised by Notice in the Inverness Courier on the 29th May 2026 and the effect of the Order is as described in that Notice.

A copy of the draft TRO, schedule, plan and the Authority's Statement of Reasons, along with The Highland Council (Woodside of Culloden Various Roads) (50MPH Speed Limit) Order 2023, which will be revoked in part if the proposed order comes into force can be inspected at the Inverness Service Point, Town House, Castle Street, Inverness, IV1 1JJ during normal opening hours from Monday to Friday 10:00 – 12:30 and 1:30 to 4:30, from the 7th August 2026 to 18th September 2026. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that a requirement of that Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the Court of Session.
