

**THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (SEABANK ROAD, NAIRN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2026**

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as 'The Highland Council (Seabank Road, Nairn) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2026' and shall come into force on the 8th day of September 2026 and will remain in effect for a maximum of 18 months.
2. The reason for making the Order is that the Council, as Roads Authority is satisfied in terms of Section 14 (1) (b) of the 1984 Act that traffic on the road should be restricted or prohibited due to the likelihood of danger to the public. The Order will prevent vehicles parking on one side of the road at the bend, ensuring traffic can pass safely through this section of the carriageway and reducing the risk of conflict between opposing vehicles.
3. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads, whether or not by mechanical power;
"Parking Enforcement Officer" has the same meaning as "parking attendant" in section 63A of the 1984 Act;
"wait" and "park" refers to the stopping of a vehicle and it remaining at rest for some time whether or not the driver is still in the vehicle.
4. Subject to Article 5 of this Order, no person shall except under the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or Parking Enforcement Officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or park on any length of road which is identified on the map (TTRO1) to this Order which is identified as being a length of road upon which a "No Waiting at Any Time" restriction applies.
5. Emergency services' vehicles, being used in an emergency for ambulance, coastguard, fire brigade or police purposes, are exempt from the restrictions and prohibitions detailed in this Order.
6. All provisions contained in any Order, Enactment, or others in so far as the same repeat or are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order and the true intent or meaning hereof shall cease to have effect during the period stated in Article 1 of this Order.

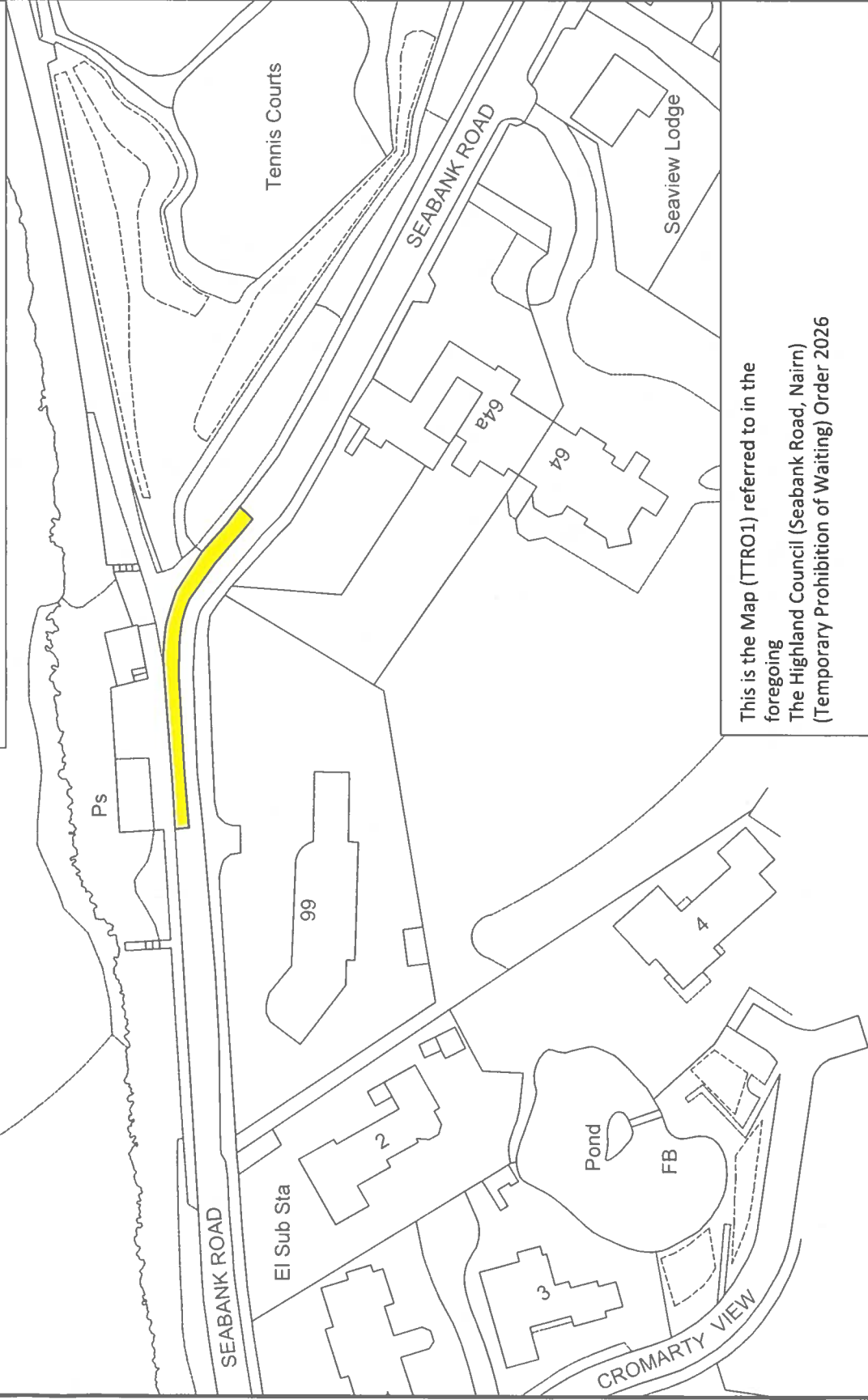
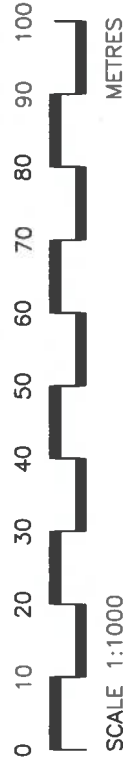
