3. Policy Updates

3.1 The policies listed have been superseded by subsequent documents or the development of other Council policies. A summary of the current status of these is given below.

The Highland Council's Statement of Strategic Goals and Values

This document has been superseded several times and was previously published as "Highland First", agreed by the Council on 13th August 2015.

Roads and Transport Goals

Although the majority of these goals are still valid, this document is out of date. Priorities have been set by subsequent Council and Service publications such as the Programme for The Highland Council and Community Services Service Plan.

Township Road Policy

This policy has not been applied since the 1990's and is superseded by subsequent Council budget decisions.

Policy for Bringing Unadopted Roads up to Adoptive Standard

This policy has been superseded by the implementation of the Roads and Transport Guidelines for New Developments.

Interim Roads and Transport Strategy Document

This document is superseded by the Local Transport Strategy, 2010.
