## Fully wheelchair accessible properties in Highland Council stock.

Questions following on from Council 13 May 2021

## 1. "How many ground-floor, wheelchair-accessible properties are in the Council estate?"

As at 16 May 2021, there are 271 ground floor Council houses that are wheelchair accessible.

Please note that we are using the definition provided in the annual Scottish Government Housing Return that defines these as fully wheelchair liveable (fully accessible housing for people confined to wheelchairs indoor and outdoor).

2. "What is the waiting list for Highland residents who want ground-floor, wheelchair-accessible properties i.e. how many people are on the housing list and have high accessibility need points allocated to them?"

As at 16 May 2021, there were 127 Highland Housing Register applicants who indicated that they had a wheelchair-accessible property need. The figures in brackets indicate the total number of applicants who have subsequently been awarded medium or high accessible housing points by the NHS Occupational Therapist (96 of the 127 applicants).
