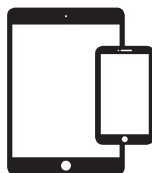

The Project will cover the Victorian Market surrounding streets, Union Street, Queensgate, Church Street, Academy Street and along to Falcon Square.

The service is now live and this is the first phase before the main roll out early 2017 for the whole city centre.

This open WiFi network is truly free for all users and has no restrictions on time, with fast internet coverage provided in the Victorian Market area for residents and visitors seeking to log-on while on the go.

- Start enjoying the free WiFi!

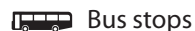

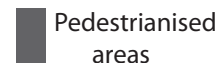

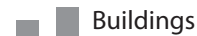
